


Nature Playground

- Area two will begin once Area one is completed




This is the area to the right of the school hall, against the fence running alongside the access laneway.

This area incorporates the trees that are currently shading part of the oval. The far right of this play space butts up against the edge of the basketball court.














Percentage of Parents / Caregivers who agree with the given statements


